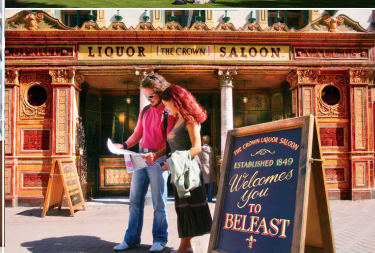
Belfast & the Titanic Museum

Steeped in history, tradition, folklore and unique charm the vibrant city of Belfast with its distinctive landmarks is now revitalised and has joined the ranks of Europe's most popular visitor destinations. 2012 marks the centenary of the Titanic's tragic maiden voyage, and Belfast is going all out to commemorate the event with the opening of the Titanic Belfast museum. The adventure begins the moment you walk through the door and into the building's giant atrium surrounded by the four high impact 'hull' shaped sections which house the experience. As you wander up through Titanic Belfast, you will experience a thrilling ride through the re-construction of the shipyards and the Titanic under construction. The stories of passengers, crew and the heroes of the day will be told in an exciting and modern way. At the conclusion, you can visit the wreck at her resting place on the floor of the North Atlantic.

Day One: We travel to Holyhead Port for our Irish Sea crossing to Dun Laoghaire, then continue north to Belfast and the Hilton Hotel where we stay for the next two nights.

Day Two: This morning we are joined by a professional guide for a Titanic themed tour of the city, offering you the opportunity to visit some key sites in the history of the construction and launch of the greatest liner ever built in Belfast, as well as exploring some of the city's other sights and famous landmarks. Following lunch we spend the remainder of the afternoon at the newly opened Titanic Museum. Housed in an iconic, 6-floor building, this state-of-the-art visitor experience tells the story of the Titanic from her birth in Belfast to the fateful maiden voyage and her eventual discovery on the seabed.

Day Three: After breakfast this morning we check-out and commence our return journey south to Dun Laoghaire for our Irish Sea crossing back to Holyhead.
